Solo: 20 Eur

Duo/Trio/Quartet: 15 Eur

Group/Formation: 10 Eur

### Important Deadlines

The registration deadline FOR OUR FIRST VIRTUAL COMPETITION is May 25th, 2020 at 23:59.

Deadline for video submission of routines is May 27th, 2020 at 23:59.

Payment deadline: 27<sup>th</sup> May.

### Judging

We will be offering critiques by 3 trained and qualified judges for each routine.

### Awards

We will do ONE LIVE awards ceremony on May 30th (depending on how many entries register).

We will announce adjudications and overall awards at our live ceremony.

FDJ will only provide to all dancers PDF files of certificate of attendance and placement and we will send on your school email and one medal for all of them sent to your club address after the competition.

The winners of the first, second and third place will receive trophies (one per formation, group/ duo/ trio/ quartet). We send all trophies on your school account without charge.

The winners of the first, second and third place in solo will receive medals. All of them will be sent to club address.

### Policies

Current skill levels, time limits, competition rules regarding music and costuming as stated in our Rules & Regulations still apply. Independent entries are welcome still unless your studio is already registering for the Virtual Competition.

Depending on the development of the COVID-19 situation, we understand gatherings to film may not be possible. We accept videos from a stage performance as long as there are no logos or graphics anywhere on the video (Ex: Other competition or convention names, studio names or logos **in the griddle**). On the back of the stage is permitted.

We also accept routines filmed at home or non-competitive environments as long as the dance space is adequate.

**Other details to keep in mind when filming:**

- Minimize background items so that the dancer is clearly seen.
- No other individuals may be in the video except the dancer. (e.g. person recording in the background)
- Be sure to film video from the front so the judges can see the routine just as if they were there.
- Your final video should contain no graphics, intros, or exits
- All video submissions must be unedited with no splicing.
- We encourage dancers to submit a fully realized routine with costume, hair, and makeup.

**How to Submit Videos**

Login to Dance Comp Genie

Once you have registered routine(s) you will see "Upload Video" option on your account

Drag or drop your video from your computer OR Download Dakiki app on your phone and log into your DCG account to upload video

Must be an .MP4 or .MOV file (minimum 1MB)

All videos must be submitted on your account no later than May 27th at 23:59.
